*Remember the coin boxes the children filled over the Easter season? The funds are all in and counted. The children's coins bought a goat from Heifer International, an organization founded to help hungry people feed themselves.*

*Goats can thrive in extreme climates and on poor, dry land by eating grass and leaves. The gift of a dairy goat can supply a family with up to several quarts of nutritious milk a day - a ton of milk a year. Extra milk can be sold or used to make cheese, butter or yogurt. Families learn to use goat manure to fertilize gardens.*

*Goats often have two or three kids a year making it easy for Heifer recipients to pass on the gift of a goat to another family in need. This great investment allows recipient families to lift themselves out of poverty by starting small dairies that earn money for food, health care and education.*
